TESTIMONY

This young brother has a miraculous life-story. He's 32 yrs old; my wife & I have known him most of his life.

Regrettably, a number of years ago, he made some harmful decisions and got into serious trouble with the Law. In Ukraine, you don't want to get in trouble with their idea of 'The Law.' The conflict with Russia is not new; it's endured for 8 years. My friend was permitted to make a deal. He would join the Army rather than go to jail.

Though raised in a Christian home, he was not a believer. While serving, he was hit by a piece of shrapnel - in his belt buckle! He was not hurt - even a little bit. Last year, he gave his heart to the Lord; then started his own business, which I patronized twice earlier this year. I felt it was my Christian duty to bless (eat at) his diner.

Vicki and I are very proud of this special friend. When Russia invaded on February 24th, he immediately re-enlisted & serves on the front lines. Although he would disagree, I believe his courage makes him a true hero.

Again, helping this brother is made possible only thru the generosity of our partners. Many of you have already given and we thank you. Some have not. Although presently not featured as the major news story on most TV networks, the war and the killing goes on. The suffering is inhuman. One city had no running water for weeks.

I conclude by asking for continued giving to Ukraine. A gentle reminder: for Vicki & I to sustain our world-wide outreach, we also need your ongoing financial support for the general expenses of *Harvest Fellowship*.
